## SHORT TERM WATER USE REPORT

This form is to be used to report the diversion of more than 100,000 gallons of water per day for periods of less than 31 days within a consecutive 365 day period. This form must be submitted within one month of the conclusion of the diversion activity. At least thirty (30) days prior to the start of the diversion activity, a Short Term Water Use Permit-by-Rule Form (BWA-003) must be filed with the Bureau of Water Allocation & Well Permitting. Upon completion of pumping, BWA-004 shall be submitted within 30 days. For diversions which will last 31 days or more, a Water Allocation Permit is required and the owner of the project should contact this office to obtain the appropriate application forms.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:19-2.17(a)2, any well or surface water supply system which becomes damaged, dry, has reduced capacity, reduced water quality or is otherwise rendered unusable as a result of this diversion shall be repaired or replaced at the expense of the owner of the project.
