Advisory: Notice of Substantial Changes Upon Adoption Regarding N.J.A.C. 6A:32, School District Operations

Trenton, NJ – At its Jan. 5, 2022, public meeting, the State Board of Education approved the following rulemaking for publication in the Feb. 7, 2022, *New Jersey Register:*

Notice of substantial changes upon adoption to the proposed readoption with amendments of *N.J.A.C.* 6A:32, School District Operations. The proposed changes upon adoption are related to the proposed rules regarding virtual and remote instruction.

The notice can be viewed at the New Jersey Department of Education's <u>Administrative Code and Statute webpage</u>.

Public testimony on the rulemaking is scheduled for March 2, 2022. As the State Board of Education continues to meet remotely, only written testimony will be accepted. Individuals can submit testimony to the State Board of Education via email.

Members of the public also may send in written comments concerning the notice by April 8, 2022, via the Department's Administrative Code and Statute webpage or via the mailing or the email addresses contained in the notice.
