## **Advisory: Proposed Readoption with Amendments of N.J.A.C. 6A:3, Controversies and Disputes**

**Trenton, NJ** – At its November 1, 2023 public meeting, the State Board of Education approved the following rulemaking for publication in the December 18, 2023, New Jersey Register:

Readoption with amendments of N.J.A.C. 6A:3, Controversies and Disputes, which sets forth the rules of procedure established by the Department for the filing of petitions with the Commissioner of Education to hear and decide controversies and disputes arising under school laws.
