WHAT IS THE ESCAPE ROOM?

The escape room is a live interactive training where teams of 5-6 people will work together over 30 minutes to navigate Clutterbug's clever traps and help unite with Captain Germ-B-Gone to proclaim victory.

There are four stations which cover hand hygiene, source control, personal protective equipment (PPE) and cleaning and disinfecting that reinforces specific standard infection and control objectives throughout.

OBJECTIVES OF THE TRAINING INCLUDE:

- 1. Defining hand hygiene and properly demonstrating the correct steps of hand hygiene
- 2. Defining source control and learning how respiratory droplets spread
- 3. Articulating and demonstrating how to correctly don and doff PPE
- 4. Recognizing how to identify contact time on a disinfectant label as well as identify high touch areas in healthcare facilities
