Fact Sheet - Section 3 - Domestic Status

<u>Marriage</u> is an established legal union for either same or opposite sex couples that require a license.

<u>Civil union</u> is an established legal union for same sex couples that require a license.

Application for License

- In State residents Apply in the local municipality where either applicant resides (proof required)
- Out of State residents Apply in the municipality where the ceremony will be held
- Ceremony outside of NJ Comply with the laws of that State, territory or Country

Application Requirements

- Proof of identity in the form of current, valid, government (not necessarily US government) issued photo identification.
- SSN For all US citizens
- A witness 18 years of age or older
- A fee of \$28.00 due at the time of application

The License

- Issued after the mandatory 72 hour waiting period lapses or a waiver obtained
- Calculate the expiration date
 - 30 days from the date of issuance including weekends and holidays

For example: If a license is issued on December 4th at 2PM, then December 5th at 2PM is day 1.

Printed and signed names of licensing registrar must match

Individuals who wish to establish a legal union in NJ are permitted to do so with a first cousin but are prohibited in doing so with a relative of either half or whole blood for any relationship such as:

- Any ancestor or descendant
- Sibling
- Biological child
- Niece or Nephew
- Mother
- Father

<u>Domestic partnership</u> is a registered event, not a licensed event, for couples who are same or opposite sex, both 62 years of age or older.
