

## Demographic Characteristics of Fatally-Injured Workers

From 1990-2013, 94% (2,331) of the work-related fatalities were male. Twenty-five percent (623) of the cases ranged in age from 35-44 years old; 74% (1,817) were White; and 18% (451) were of Hispanic origin.
