CMS INTEROPERABILITY RULE Documentation for Third-party App Developers

The Interoperability and Patient Access final rule requires the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) regulated payers to implement and maintain conformant, standards-based Application Programming Interfaces (APIs) that enable patients to access their health information through a third-party application of their choice.

The Medicaid/NJ FamilyCare program is required to comply with the CMS Interoperability and Patient Access Final Rule and is using the InterOp Station® to support these API connections with third-party applications.

The InterOp Station® is a platform for broad healthcare data interoperability used by the New Jersey Innovation Institute (NJII) which manages the MyNJFCHealthData service.

In order to enable API connections, third-party developers must register their app with InterOp Station® to make the app available for use by Medicaid/NJ FamilyCare members.
