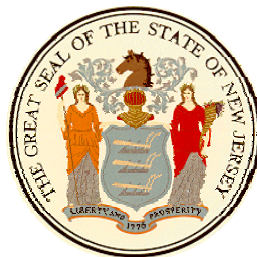

In 2008 there were 64,091 treatment admissions and 60,885 discharges reported to the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Addiction Services by substance abuse treatment providers. 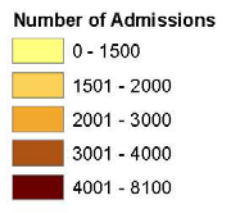

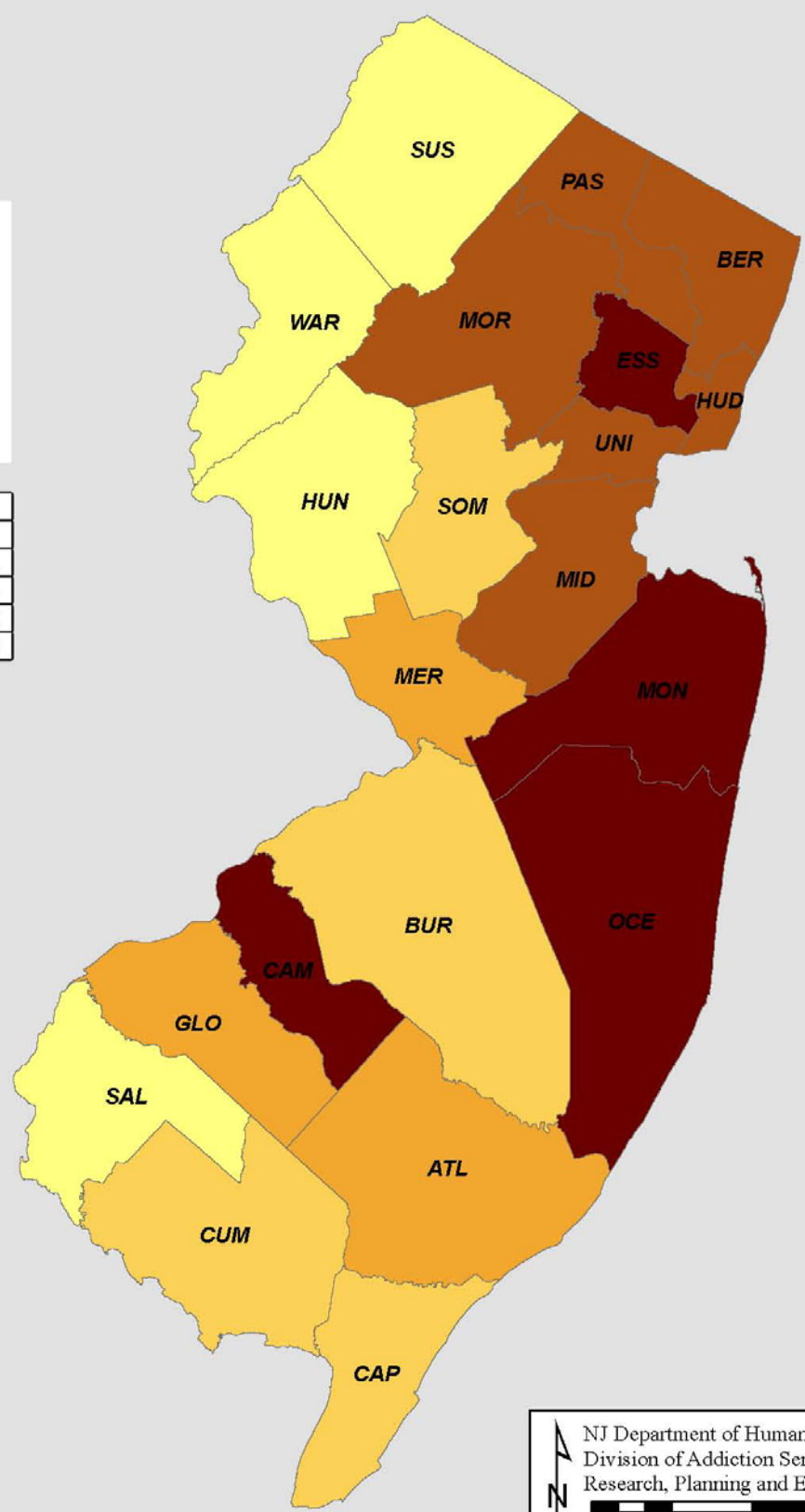

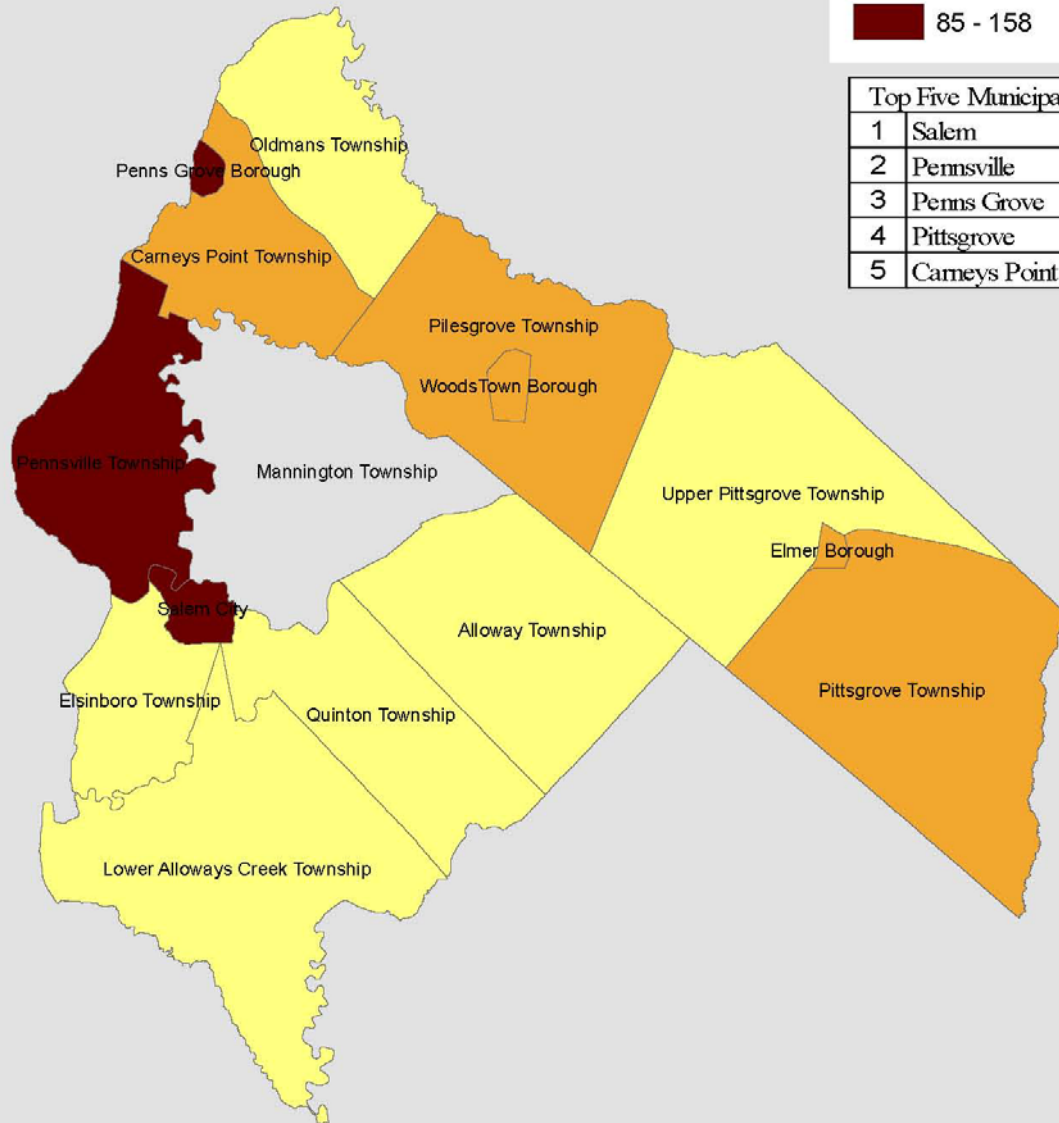
