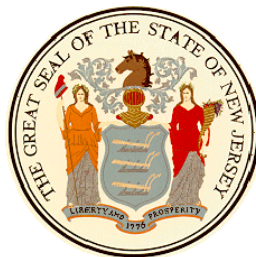

In 2010 there were 71,874 treatment admissions and 70,594 discharges reported to the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Addiction Services by substance abuse treatment providers. 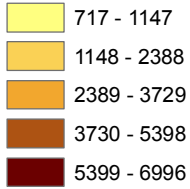

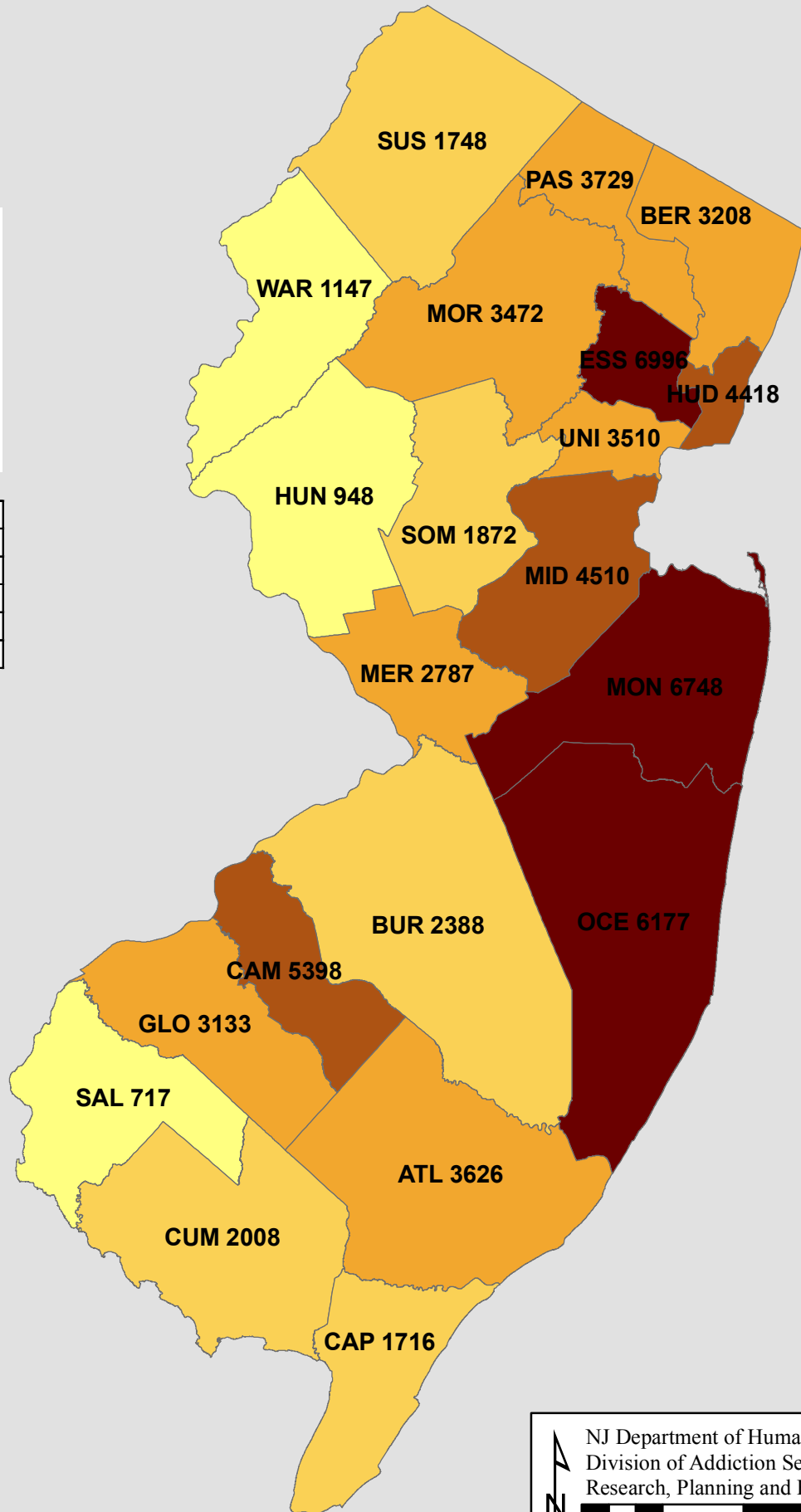

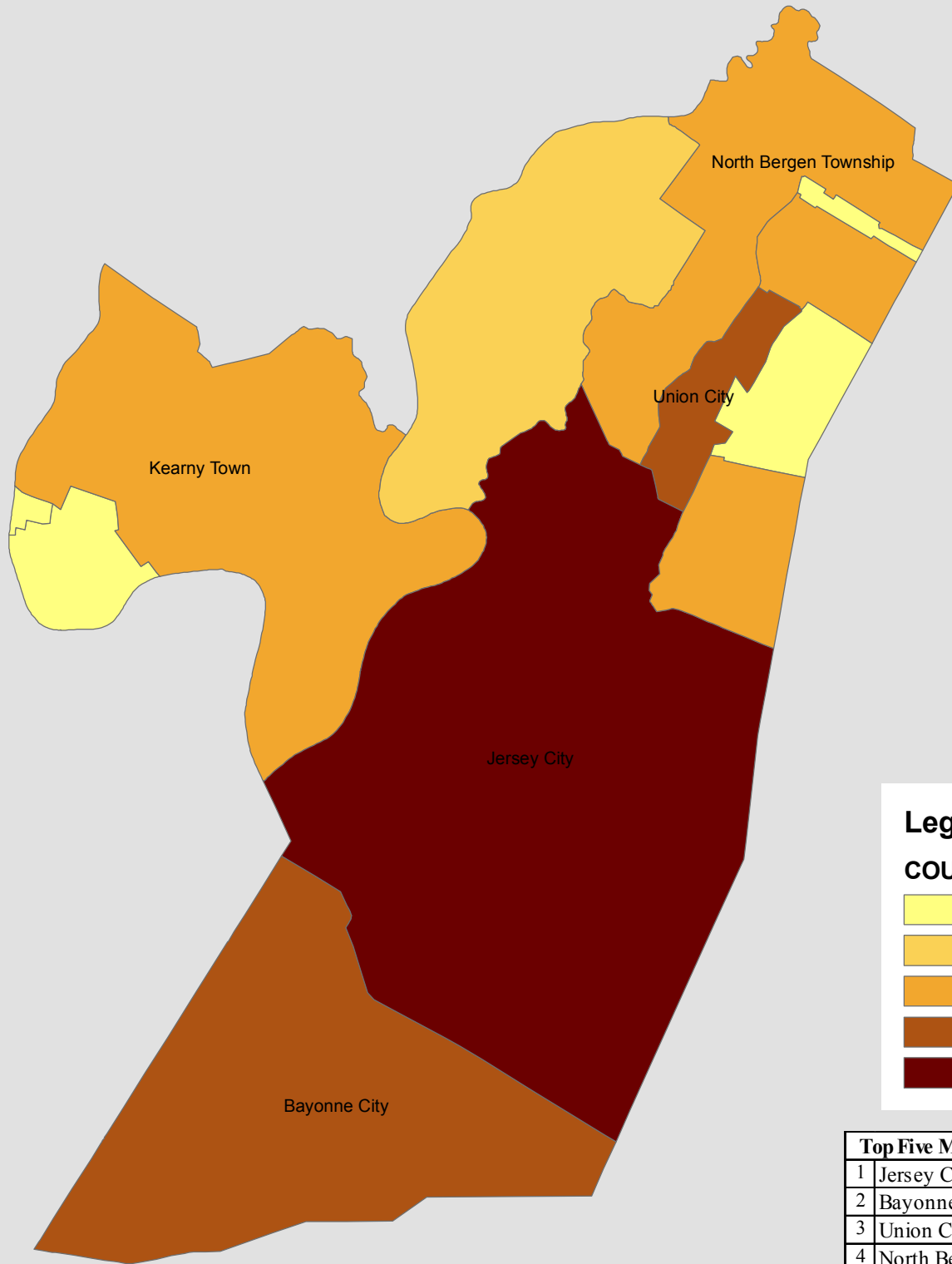
