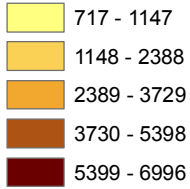

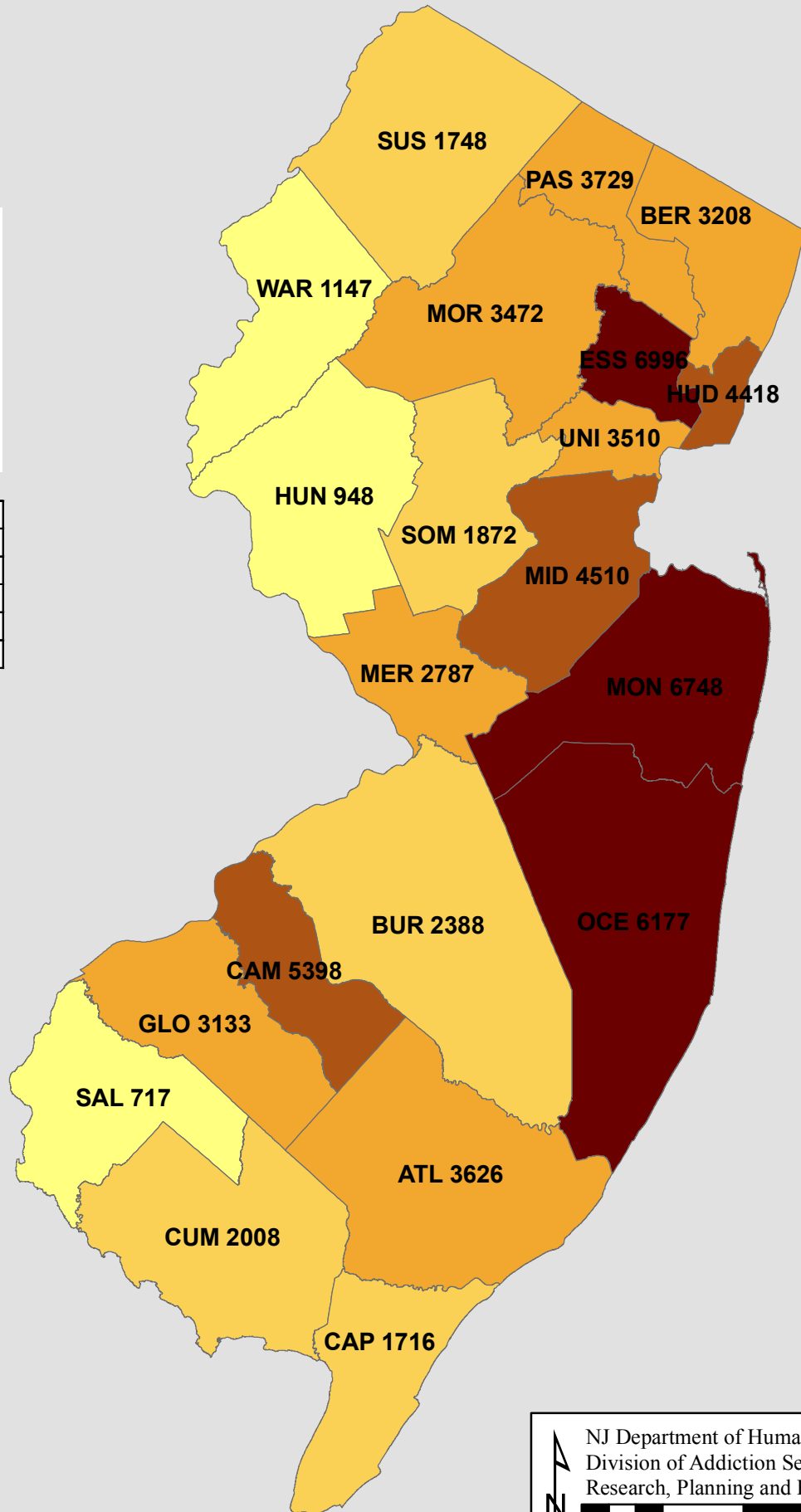

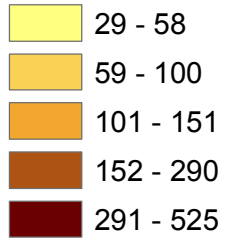

2010 Middlesex County Substance Abuse Admissions by Municipality of Residence

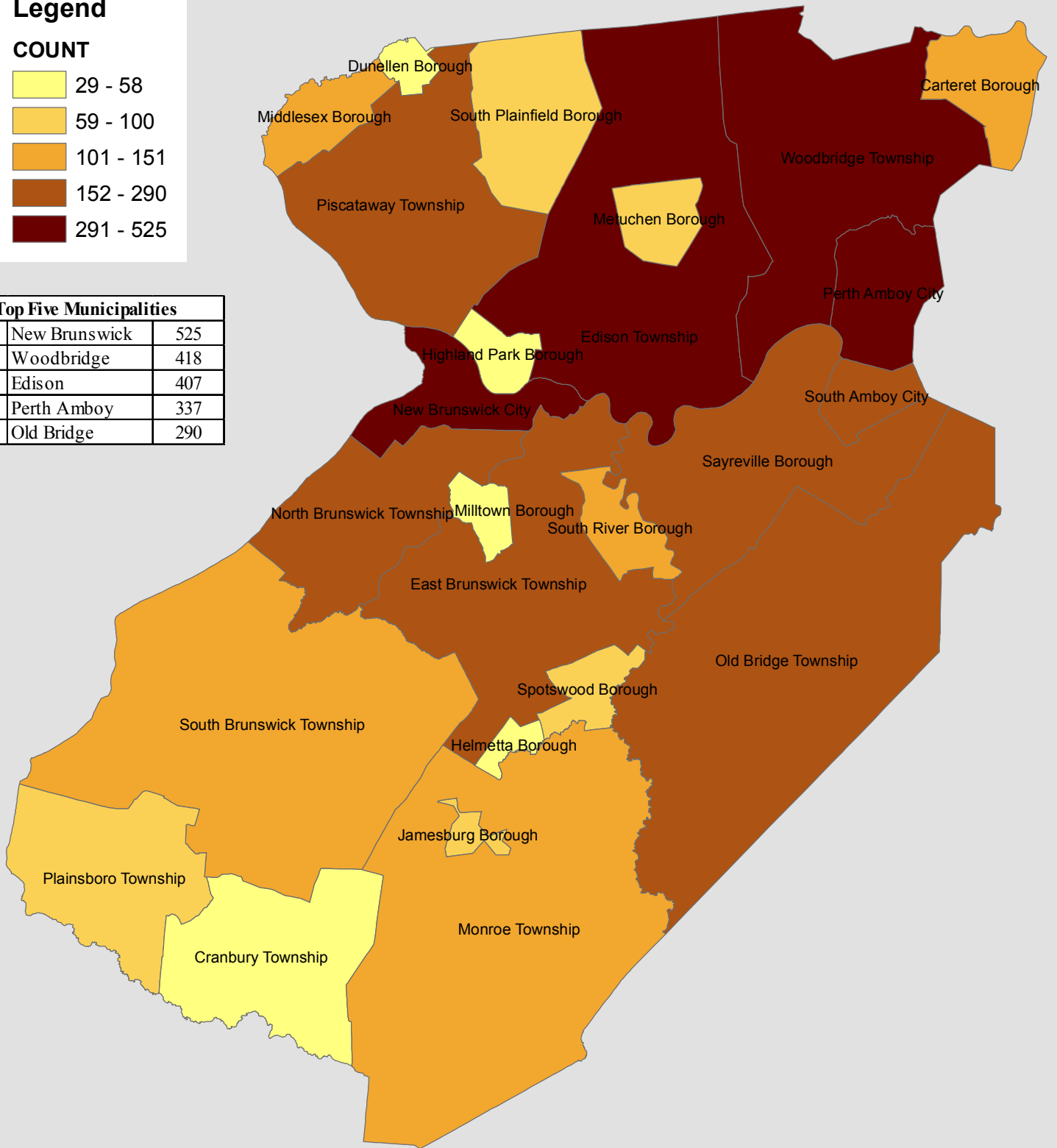
