SUBJECT: Administrative Order 2020-02 (IRP and IFTA Temporary Extension)

Pursuant to the State of Emergency as declared in Executive Order No. 103 (2020), issued by Governor Philip D. Murphy March 9, 2020, I, B. Sue Fulton, Chair and Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, have signed Administrative Order 2020-02, which temporarily extends all International Registration Plan ("IRP") registrations ("cab cards") and Temporary IRP registrations, with expiration dates between March and May, 2020, until May 31, 2020. This extension applies to New Jersey commercial carriers/vehicles.

- 1. The Administrative Order also provides a temporary waiver of the International Registration Plan ("IRP") requirement that an out-of-state carrier apply for and obtain from the MVC a temporary registration credential known as a "Trip Permit" or "Temporary Authorization" in accordance with section N.J.A.C. 13:18-2.13 of the New Jersey regulations implementing and governing IRP; and
- 2. A temporary waiver of the International Fuel Tax Agreement ("IFTA") that an out-of-state carrier apply for and obtain a licensing permit credential known as a "Trip Permit" in accordance with section N.J.A.C. 13:18-3.5 of the New Jersey regulations implementing and governing IFTA.
