Per an August 1, 2010 change to state law, all registered vehicles that are four model years or newer are granted a one-year extension to the expiration date noted on the affixed inspection sticker.

Please be advised that the MVC's effort to distribute the one-year extension decals to customers who own these specific vehicles is ongoing. While nearly all customers with 2006 and 2007 vehicles have been provided the decal, it has come to the MVC's attention that not all of the affected vehicle owners have received the decals.

The MVC is reminding the law enforcement and legal community that motorists should not be cited for an expired vehicle inspection sticker if their vehicle is subject to this change in state law and they have not yet received the extension decal. The MVC anticipates that all extension decals should be distributed to all affected customers prior to the end of 2010.
