11 municipalities plan responsibly by insuring

13 the jurisdictions. I'm not even sure if I
14 am phrasing it right, but a balance of
15 housing and employment opportunities in each
16 municipality would reduce the number of
17 peak-hour, single-occupant vehicle trips,
18 trips during the peak hours in general, and
19 also the length of time and the actual
20 distance of a trip. It just seems like it
21 would be something that would be useful in
22 New Jersey, especially since all the
23 planning is done pretty much at the
24 municipal level. That's it.

1 MS. TUCKER: I didn't see anything
2 like that in the recommendations.

3 CHAIRMAN SINCLAIR: We will add
