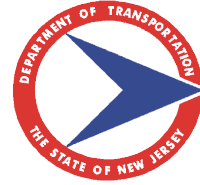

### **REASON FOR THE CHANGES:**



This revision must be read in conjunction with the referenced BDC Announcements.


**Implementation Code R (ROUTINE)**
