# Public Transportation Safety Certification Training Program Requirements

**Current Version:** 10/01/2021

**Scope:** This procedure explains the requirements for minimum training, based on FTA’s Public Transportation Safety Certification Training Program (PTSCTP) certificate program defined in 49 CFR Part 672.

### Training Period

Employees currently in the positions listed above must meet all requirements as soon as reasonably possible or within the three-year regulatory requirement of becoming “designated staff”. This also includes contractor staff.
