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Fiscal Year 2017 Tax Collections Ahead of Last Year

TRENTON – The New Jersey Department of the Treasury announced February revenue collections, showing continued year-over-year growth. Year-to-date collections total \$17.5 billion, a 5.1 percent or \$843.76 million increase above last year.

As part of his recent budget message, Governor Christie updated anticipated revenue collections for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2017 to incorporate recent tax changes and trends. Gross Income Tax (GIT) and Sales Tax revenues are up for the year and are in line with projections, as the State enters the all-important spring tax filing season. Greater than anticipated refunds and a shift to monthly reallocation rather than annual allocation of certain Corporation Business Tax (CBT) receipts are responsible for a decline in CBT revenues, but CBT revenues are also in line with projections after accounting for the methodology change.

Total tax collections increased 31.2 percent to \$2.1 billion for the month of February.

Taxpayer refunds for the 2016 Tax Year will be reflected in upcoming revenue reports.

- (a) February 2017 and February 2017 YTD include a reclassification from Corporation Business Tax to Gross Income Tax relating to partnership fees of \$17.4 million and \$207.2 million respectively. In prior years, this adjustment was made during the year-end closing process.
- (b) Pursuant to P.L. 03-13, \$202.2 million of FY 2017 Motor Vehicle Fee collections are dedicated to the New Jersey Motor Vehicle
- (c) Pursuant to P.L. 06-37, revenue collections of \$396.5 million from the eigarette and tobacco products wholesale sales tax are deposited in the Health Care Subsidy Fund. Pursuant to P.L. 04-69, \$0.0325 per cigarette is dedicated to pay debt service on the Cigarette Securitization Bonds.
- (d) Approximately \$85.9 million for the month and \$221.6 million YTD is attributable to the recent gas tax increases imposed under P.L. 2016, C.57 which are constitutionally dedicated to the Transportation Trust Fund.
